As the BOD meeting progresses, the delegates are often called upon to vote on issues that arise. The following notice of motion has been given and perhaps you might like to let your delegates know your feelings on the matter so that they will know how the region wants them to vote.

The motion reads as follows:

Moved by Merv Meyers and seconded by Allen Ebl that all future Federation Board of Directors Meetings be held in a location within 25 kilometers of Abbotsford, B.C.

This motion would change the following current bylaw which reads:

Article 5 Meetings

5.3 Board of Directors Meetings

(i) The Board of Directors

shall meet in the spring of each year, with time and place to be decided at the previous meeting.

This motion has arisen due to the difficulty and the expenses that some regions encounter when required to attend meetings that are located so far away. For example - our delegates in Prince George having to attend a meeting in Victoria at 9:00 AM would need to book time off work in order to attend and they would incur extra hotel expenses which our region can not afford to pay. The same goes for delegates from Vancouver Island if they had to attend a meeting in Prince George or even in Dawson Creek. What are your feelings in this matter?

The president of the Federation, Norm Cox, is also planning to have a Round Table discussion during the meeting. The discussion topic is "Where Does Your Federation Go From Here? His comment on this is, "We seem to be standing at a crossroad not knowing whether to go up the hill or down and we are almost out of Our numbers are certainly going gas. downward. Our present Executive is very busy within their own Regions. Also Regions are having trouble getting Delegates to attend the Federation meeting – some Regions have no money to help with the expenses incurred in attending those meetings. We need a plan for today as well as one for tomorrow -``5 - 10 years``.
