

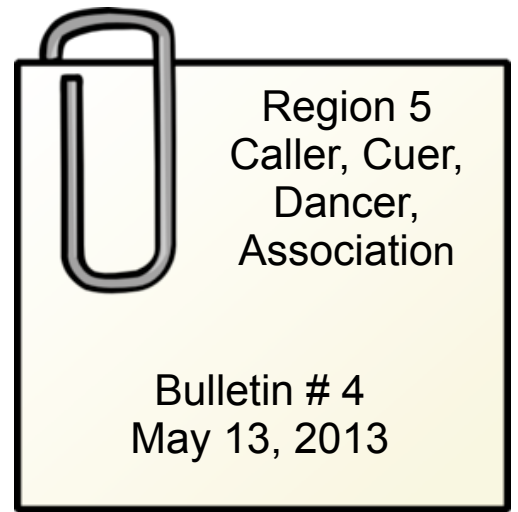

    - FourScore and More Badges – Connie and Al Ritchie -owners of “Sandy’s Badges”, will now be running this program after John Tutte resigned as coordinator.
    - Beth McGifford, a delegate to the Canadian Society stressed it is imperative to provide accurately spelled names of dancers; suggested to keep a copy of the lists as sent in; we discussed the keeping of an attendance record at nightly dances and parties: as long as it is legible—and the importance of our clubs being registered. If an incident happens, make sure someone takes all the details of the incident: witnesses’ names and addresses, times, dates, location, description of incident, details. Our registration certificate tells us to contact the insurance company. If dancing across the border, carry additional coverage.

- a motion to hold future BOD meetings within 25 km of Abbotsford BC. because it is more central and would cut down on expenses for most people was discussed and **defeated**
